Experience Children's Rights through different variations of Football

This module introduces a few different versions of football that can be used to introduce the subject of children's rights in a playful way.

Through the use of special rules and regulations, the football match is altered in order for children and adolescents to experience different aspects of children's rights. Participants then analyse these experiences with regard to the topic.

Used in this way, football can provide a playful and experiential introduction to children's rights.

Goals

- To promote critical thinking and the ability to reflect
- To use football as a playful introduction to children's rights
- To learn something about children's rights based on individual experiences during the match
- To reflect together on the experiences of the match and connect these to the subject of children's rights
